

# Shetland Congress

## Stallion Avenue

This year the Shetland Congress will feature a Stallion Avenue where spectators may view some of the industry's top stallions "in the flesh" and visit with their owners. Stallion Avenue will be limited to 18 stallions which will be stalled in the front row of stalls just outside of the coliseum entrance at the 2010 Shetland Congress in Ardmore, OK.

The cost for stallions to be featured on Stallion Avenue is \$250. Stallions on Stallion Avenue will receive the following:

- Stall on Stallion Avenue
- Stall Door Sign with stallion's name
- Full page ad in the Congress Show Program
- Presentation during the Parade of Stallion Avenue where Stallions will be presented to the audience in the coliseum
